

# Answers

In 1982 when Kingston Lacy in Dorset was bequeathed to the National Trust there was a discovery in the library.

Two pages were found that came from one of the 'other' bibles that were made in Jarrow at the same time as the Codex Amiatinus.

It is thought the bible came into the possession of Worcester Cathedral in the Middle Ages. The pages were used for binding estate records in Nottinghamshire.
