# A message from Father Adrian

I can't believe how quickly ten years have passed. The time has flown and I have enjoyed it all. I would like to thank you all for your great patience and kindness; it has been a joy and a privilege to serve as a priest here. Not long after I arrived a minister of one of the other denominations remarked that the Catholic community of Jarrow has a tremendous presence in the town and I have certainly seen that to be true. The ways in which members of our parishes work for the good of the whole community, the witness and commitment to faith, have been absolutely remarkable.

It calls to mind that idea of how we stand on the shoulders of giants; so many people over the years have handed on their faith and provided practical help to those who struggle both here and far away. And it still goes on.

I am conscious that we have all been through the trauma of Covid and the ripple of its effects reach us still. Wonderful to see, was how in various ways people persevered in their spiritual lives and supported each other in numerous ways especially when there was bereavement and sickness.

I have had the privilege of conducting the funerals of some saints as impressive as those we read about in books. I give thanks for having known so many people who are now with God.

The celebration of the Sacraments is at the heart of a priest's life and I have found it moving and uplifting to be with you at these times, especially with the young as they set out on their journey. We have fantastic schools here that have been, and are being, led by gifted and committed staff; we all owe them our thanks.

In my time I have been blessed by some really wonderful fellow clergy, Father Peter, Father Saji and Deacon Kevin. Each brings to their ministry something special and inspiring. I know that Saint Mary's and Saint Matthew's have in their priest a truly wonderful shepherd. I would especially like to thank Father Saji for his gentle ministry, his vision and his calm effectiveness. Sister Mary Lees has been a wise and helpful support in her ministry in Saint Bede's and I thank her for her guidance and advice. There is a great crowd of you who minister within the four parishes of Jarrow and the service that you give truly makes the Church here live. Thank you for your service. I have been overwhelmed by the gifts, cards and good wishes of you all; it has made me think I must leave parishes more often! Seriously, you have been extraordinarily generous, and I shall never forget your kindness.

The time comes for me to move on, and I thank God for having sent me to Jarrow. I thank God for sending me to Billingham; the call is a powerful reminder that he still has work for me to do and I ask your prayers that I may do it.

In Father Andrew Shaw you have a wonderful young(!) priest and I know that he will rely on your help and support as he helps you travel further down the pilgrim way of the Church. He will do things differently to the way I do and that is to be honoured and celebrated. I suspect he will be punctual and on time, and that is something for me to admire. Keep him in your prayers.
