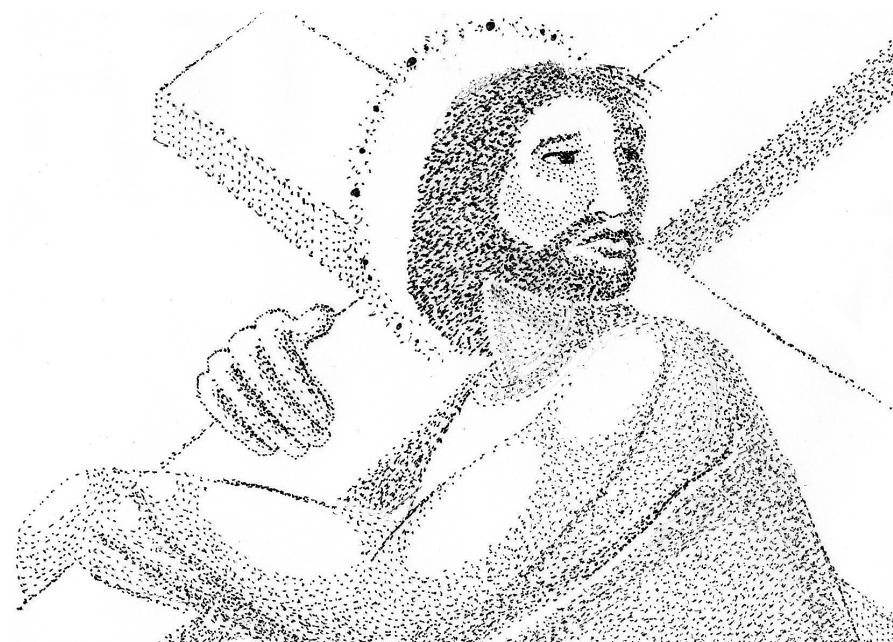

TWENTY THIRD SUNDAY OF THE YEAR 8 SEPT 2019



Today's challenging readings ask us to re-think our attitudes and ways. The Book of Wisdom reminds us that, when it comes to real understanding, even the wisest person barely scrapes the surface. Paul's provocative letter to Philemon praises him for his understanding of the social order (which includes slavery) and for his good treatment of Onesimus. Then Paul drops his bombshell: he tells Philemon that Onesimus is now a Christian and should be treated as such - as a brother, an equal and welcomed as Philemon would welcome Paul himself! The Gospel tells us that if we are to follow Jesus, we must do some serious planning but to be willing to accept that our plans will never be enough. If we walk on the Way with Jesus without being aware of what is involved we will miss the joy and happiness of a totally fulfilled life that Jesus, despite today's apparently negative language, is holding out to us
