

THE RETURN OF MASSES We celebrate Mass at St Aloysius on:

- ***Wednesday at 7pm.***
- ***Saturday at 6pm.***
- ***Sunday at 11am.***

- Please don't come if you have a temperature or the other symptoms of coronavirus.
- You must use the hand sanitiser when you enter church and as you leave.
- Please follow the one-way system, up the side aisles and down the centre aisle.
- When Fr Simon is receiving Holy Communion he will say loudly **The Body of Christ** we will say together **Amen**. So that when we receive communion we will say nothing.
- Once we have received communion we must leave church.
- If you want to talk to someone you must do it in the car park, keeping social distances.
- If there are any questions please see Fr Simon.

Due to Government ruling masks **MUST** be worn at all Church Services/Masses and you will have to ring this phone number **07594918476** to leave your name and phone number to book a place for weekend Masses (we are only allowed 100 people to attend). You don't need to book a place for Wednesday Mass but you **MUST** wear a mask. Those who are still in isolation or would rather not risk coming to Church just yet, the Bishops of England and Wales have continued to release us from the Sunday Obligation as they did at the beginning of the lockdown.
