Going into hospital?

Current rules concerning patient confidentiality make it more difficult for chaplains to discover which patients are Catholics. Consequently, Catholics going into hospital are sometimes not visited by the chaplain or his assistants. If you are going into hospital, or a member of your family is, please let a priest know; he will ensure that the chaplain is informed. On admission, you should also tell the admission staff that you are a Roman Catholic and would like to be visited by the Roman Catholic chaplain.

Mass Intentions

The practice of offering Masses for particular intentions dates back to the early Church. The Holy Mass makes present the whole mystery of Christ's death and resurrection. There is no greater prayer, because it is the perfect offering of the Son of God to his heavenly Father. In offering Mass for a specific intention, the priest prays that the fruits of Christ's redemptive sacrifice be applied to that intention, for the good of those concerned or, if they have died, for their eternal salvation.

Envelopes are available in the porch of both churches for Mass intention requests, and any offering you are able to make. These can be handed in at either sacristy or dropped through the presbytery letterbox at St Bede's. Please indicate in which church you would like your intention to be offered (or if you have no preference). If you would like to request a particular date, the earlier you make your request, the more likely it is that it will be available. If your requested date is not available, your intention will be booked on the first available date thereafter.
