TWENTY SIXTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR 26 SEPTEMBER 2021



By this point in Mark's Gospel, Jesus is making his way away from safety towards Jerusalem. He frequently speaks openly about his impending death. He is preparing his disciples for life without him.

In teaching *'Whoever is not against us is for us.'* Jesus calls his disciples to be God's generous and welcoming hosts who throw the doors of the kingdom wide open, who understand that there's enough divine goodness, mercy, and justice to go around. Hosts who trust that God delights in diversity, who respond with joy and gratitude whenever *'deeds of power'* are done in Jesus' name. Hosts who, like Moses, long for the day when *'all the Lord's people'* will be filled to overflowing with the spirit of God. It's the simple gestures that matter: reaching out, giving our time, going the extra mile. When we use our eyes to notice the other's needs, when we use our feet to walk the extra mile, our hands and voices to build up others. Then we are building the Kingdom. Then we work miracles in His name.
