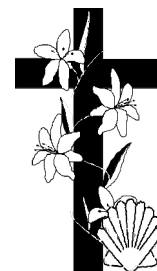

It seeks to protect unborn children from abortion and defends the disabled, elderly and incapacitated from euthanasia and assisted suicide. A collection basket is at the back of Church for any donations.

You don't need to book a place for weekday Mass but you **MUST** wear a mask. Those who are still in isolation or would rather not risk coming to Church just yet, the Bishops of England and Wales have continued to release us from the Sunday Obligation as they did at the beginning of the lockdown
